Day/Date	<u>ITINERARY FOR SOUTH AFRICA GOLF</u>	Hotel	Meals
Day 1	<p>ARRIVAL CAPE TOWN SOUTH AFRICA Arrival at Cape Town International Airport. After clearing customs and immigration you are met and transferred to your hotel situated in Cape Town's popular Victoria & Alfred Waterfront. A rich diversity of geography, vegetation, people and activities awaits you in Cape Town, "the Mother City". From soaring craggy mountains to multi-hued vineyards, endless white beaches to indigenous forests, from fishermen to sophisticated entrepreneurs - they all come together at the south-western tip of Africa. The Commodore offers stylish accommodation, state-of-the-art conference facilities, attention to detail, service excellence and splendid view of the city in a peaceful and secure environment, assuring comfort, quality and luxury at all times. Lock away facility will be provided for golf bags for easy access each morning. After check in you are taken on an orientation tour of the "Mother City". Highlights include: A Cable Car ride up the majestic Table Mountain, historic Adderley Street, the Company Gardens and the Malay Quarter with its cobbled streets. Return to the Waterfront for lunch. Day 2	<p>GOLF AT MILNERTON - CAPE TOWN Collection from your hotel and transferred to Milnerton Golf Club for 18 holes of golf. Situated near the famous Bloubergstrand, this course lies between a lagoon and the ocean and has stunning views of the Peninsula and Table Mountain. The course is not too challenging unless the South Easter is blowing, then it can turn out to be a monster. Here you meet your South African opponents and are split into teams where the competition officially begins. Return to your hotel in the afternoon where the rest of the day is at leisure. Day 3	<p>IN CAPE TOWN/PENINSULA TOUR Collection from your hotel for a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula. First visit the exclusive suburbs of Seapoint, Clifton and Camps Bay. Continue via Llandudno to the fishing harbour of Hout Bay. If calm seas prevail, join a launch cruise to view the Duiker Island seals and cormorants at close quarters. Enter the Cape Point Nature Reserve where you will be taken to the best vantage point to view what is erroneously said to be the meeting place of two mighty oceans. Continues to a Jackass penguin colony, the Naval hamlet of Simonstown and then via Fishhoek and Kalk Bay to Muizenburg. In the early afternoon visit the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens at the base of Skeleton Gorge. Return to the city via Rhodes Drive that bisects the plush suburbs of Bishops Court, Claremont and Newlands. The tour terminates at your hotel in the late afternoon. Day 5	<p>GOLF AT SPIER IN THE WINELANDS This morning we depart for wine country. Travel to Stellenbosch, second oldest town in South Africa, center of learning, rugby and the wine industry of the region. Enjoy 18 holes at the Spier County Club. This course forms part of the Spier Wine Estate. The Parkland course is challenging for most, with the river coming into play at most of the holes. A serene setting with beautiful mountain views in the midst of the winelands makes it a truly pleasurable experience. It is one of the only golf courses with its 19th hole situated in a working wine cellar. Your South African opponents join you once again for the final show down!After golf you are taken on a tour of this historic town. Highlights include: The Village Museum, Historic Dorp Street and Oom Samie se Winkel (Uncle Sam's Shop) where you can pick up inexpensive antiques from a bygone era. Also enjoy a cellar tour followed by wine tasting at the to one of many fine wine estates. Return to Spier Estate for check in at The Village Hotel. This evening enjoy a traditional South African barbeque. Relax around the open fire blazing under an African sky. Sample some of the fine wines of the Cape and enjoy the warm, friendly hospitality of your South African teammates.Prize giving and lucky draw to take place on the evening. Day 6	<p>CAPE TOWN TO THE GARDEN ROUTE/GEORGE Depart Cape Town as we travel along the coast visiting Hermanus, world renowned for all year round whale watching, before entering the scenic Garden Route. Continue to Mossel Bay. This popular holiday town is surrounded by a sunbathed peninsula and the refreshing waters of the Indian Ocean. Its most important feature is its status as the historical capital of the Garden Route. After visiting the Old Post Office Tree and Bartholomew Diaz Museum we depart for George. Nestling below the magnificent Outeniqua Mountains is the sixth oldest town in South Africa. Arrive at Fancourt Hotel & Country Club. A combination of Olde Worlde charm and contemporary luxuries is what makes the Fancourt Hotel so distinctive. At the Manor House, you will find a restful haven in a building with a history dating back to the beginnings of the 19th century: in 1847 Henry Fancourt White established a workers' base at the foot of the Outeniqua Mountains for the construction of the Montagu Pass, which you can still travel on. 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Day 7	<p>GOLF AT FANCOURT IN GEORGE Enjoy 18 holes of golf at Fancourt. The Montagu and Outeniqua are two world class Parkland layouts with the Montagu achieving the No. 1 ranking in South Africa by Golf Digest Magazine. Both courses are very similar and present a true test of golf in aesthetically beautiful surroundings. The Links course opened almost two years ago and presents a very special, and unique to South Africa, golfing experience. Already ranked as South Africa's best new course, you really could believe you are playing golf on the Scottish Coast. Bramble Hill is the fourth course on the estate and is a Parkland course with Links features and offers a nice mix of the estate's other three courses. The course is a public 'Pay for Play' facility and really has been designed to offer golfers of every level a Fancourt experience. The Golf Academy at Fancourt is a superb facility and has four full time teaching professionals attached to it, to offer expert advice and tuition. The hitting area are ideal, consisting of undercover bays, 300 sq m of immaculate turf and is complimented by a four hole learning course. Day 8	<p>FULL DAY EXCURSION TO OUDTSHOORN Today you are taken on a full day excursion to Oudtshoorn, "the ostrich capital of the world". Visit the Cango Caves, one of the world's great natural wonders, sculptured by nature through the ages. Mysterious and breathtaking limestone formations in a wide variety of natural colours, a subterranean wonderland. Continue to Highgate Ostrich Ranch, which is a fully operational ranch where you are taken on a guided tour. You may even have to opportunity to ride an ostrich! Day 9	<p>GOLF AT SPARREBOSCH/KNYSNA Today you are taken to Sparrebosch, the Classic Ocean 18, Course. With breathtaking views over the forest, the Knysna Lagoon and the Indian Ocean with holes such as the 14th built right on the breach of the cliffs the course is better known as Southern Africa's Postcard to Golf! Architects, Ron Fream and David Dale from GolfPlan, USA transformed a difficult section of coastal splendour into 18 unique and individual holes of golf. Playing from a relatively short 4700 m for the shorter hitter, to a totally challenging 6400 m for the professional, the course offers five tee locations on every hole to provide a length of play for every player. In the afternoon continue to the town of Knysna, lying on the banks of a shimmering lagoon in the heart of this 'Garden Route'. Knysna is synonymous with fine indigenous timbers, and famed for the craftsmanship of its furniture and timber products. Join a sundowner cruise on the Knysna Lagoon. 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Day 10	<p>GEORGE TO JOHANNESBURG THEN SABI SABI Morning at leisure. Collection from your hotel and transferred to George Airport for your flight to Johannesburg. Arrival at Johannesburg International where you connect with your flight to Skukuza situated inside the Kruger National Park. Arrival at Skukuza Airport where you are met by your ranger and transferred to world-renowned Sabi Sabi Private Game Reserve. Surrender your senses to the wild. Breathe the warmth of Africa, absorb the bushveld sounds and luxuriate in the elegance of the meticulously appointed lodges that overlook waterholes where herds of game come to drink. Indulge in superior service while enjoying the comforts and tranquility of the environment. Experience unsurpassed game viewing by day and at night, guided by highly qualified game rangers and skilled Shangaan trackers. Watch Africa's wild animals stalking, drinking, fighting and feeding, whilst prolific bird life soars the open skies. Alternatively, relax around the pool, browse through the safari boutique or perhaps take a siesta to make up for that early morning wake-up call. The view of the hole from the elevated tee is unforgettable and one can understand why Gary Player sincerely believes he has created one of the top courses in the world at the Lost City, with its desert-style front nine and African bushveld closing nine.
