Tsitsikamma National Park - Additional activities

Tsitsikamma tree top canopy tours

Enjoy the unequalled beauty of the indigenous forest high up on eight treetop platforms. Gently glide along in harness along steel cables 30 meters above the forest floor. Bird life is abundant (including Knysna Loeries and the elusive Narina Trojan), and your guides will explain the ecology of the lush primeval forest. Safety is paramount, and the system has been built to the highest civil engineering standards. Guides are fully trained professionals.

Departure times: Every ½ hour from 8am to 4:00pm in summer, and 9am to 2pm in winter.

Duration: About 3 hours.

Cost: R395.00 per person including light refreshments.

“Spirit of Tsitsikamma” - Eco wilderness boat cruises

Ten international tourist publications have rated the Tsitsikamma Eco Wilderness Boat Cruise a “must”, and German and British Television have both featured the cruise.

Awesome cliff faces tower 150m above the boat, as it passes huge 20m caverns along the river. Fish-Eagles and Knysna Loeries wheel above. The boat cruise is one of only two ways to see the otherwise inaccessible Stormsriver Gorge - the other way being Blackwater Tubing!

Duration: 30 minutes.

Departs from the Suspension Bridge in the Tsitsikamma National park.

Starting times 09H30 - every forty-five minutes.

Cost: Adults R35.00per person

Sea conditions permitting.

Tsitsikamma marine tour

A guided tour of the first Marine reserve in Africa.

The professionally trained guide will point out the rich marine, ecological and Khoi-san heritage to you, as you enjoy the lush indigenous forest vegetation. A feature of the day is the two kilometre walk to the suspension bridge at the Stormsriver Mouth along a wooden walk way. You will have the opportunity to see whales and dolphins through a natural feature known as the whale window.

A twenty -five minute cruise on the “spirit of Tsitsikamma” will give you an unrivalled experience of the awesome Stormsriver Gorge.

First trip starting at 09h00 / 11h00 / 14h00.

Duration: About two and a half hours.

Cost: R105.00pp

Lunch: R35.00pp

Visit Monkeyland Primate sanctuary

Monkeyland is a modern primate sanctuary established in a pristine natural high canopy forest, which is well suited to those primates fortunate enough to live there. Perhaps the Monkeyland, is unique in that the sanctuary caters for several species of primate, they are free to move about the forest, and do so in harmony.

Lunch in the lively forest of Monkeyland is a unique experience. It is the only eating spot in the world where you can actually sip your coffee while you watch a large variety of primates, from all over the world, playing - enjoying their newfound freedom.

There is a fee for the guided safaris. Note that these guided safaris are open ended which means that one may go on as many safaris as you wish, in a given day, having only paid for the first excursion.

A visit to Monkeyland is a must for every local resident of, and visitor to The Garden Route. So swing by visit this awesome monkey kingdom The primates are therefore not found on predetermined points displayed on a map, the emphasis is to search for them, and the reward is to see them as they should be free and in the wild.

Addo National Park - Additional activities

Addo elephant back safaris

A unique opportunity to be one in nature with these awe-inspiring gentle giants. Addo Elephant Back Safaris is situated in the pristine valleys of the Zuurberg Mountains within the recently proclaimed Greater Addo Elephant Park. This area is regarded as Africa’s most biologically diverse, supporting 4 of the 7 biomes or eco regions in Southern Africa. During the walk, informative guides will provide information on this unique area. After the walk relax at the boma overlooking the elephant’s favourite water hole.

R1250 / person including refreshments on the ride followed by a light meal.

Walks with the elephants are available during the elephant’s leisure time between 11h00 - 15h00. Guests can arrive at anytime and will be taken to the elephants and can remain with them for as long as they would like to. Walks allow the elephants to be observed in their natural surroundings. R650 per person

Addo Horse Trails

Addo Park: Breathtaking horse trails through Addo & Zuurberg allow you to become one with the African bush. Experienced Riders: 3 hour guided horse trail within the elephant park with rare opportunities of viewing game close up (14h00 - 17h00 @ R150 per person). Novice Riders: 2 hour guided horse trail next to the game fence (08h00 - 10h00 @ R100 per person).

Zuurberg Mountain Horse Trails: 1, 3 and 5 hour routes available. Rate: R70 (1 hour); R90 (2 hours); R110 (3 hours).

Citrus Farms: Trails among beautiful citrus orchards and along the famous Sundays River.
